2. Offer you, and the other party involved in the case, limited mediation services to help the parties work through and create agreements.

The WORKS CLINIC CANNOT:

- Represent you in court.
- Be responsible for the outcome of your case or file anything on your behalf with the Clerk of Courts.
- Provide you with individualized legal strategies for your case.
- Offer you a privileged attorney-client relationship.
